When will we know the results of the Congressional District Level elections?

Congressional Level Delegates will be announced on the AZDem website on May 4th.

What are the representation goals?

In cooperation with the National Committee, the State Party has determined the demographic composition of African Americans, Latinx, Native Americans, and Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders in the state's Democratic electorate. These constituency percentages shall be established as goals for representation in the state's convention delegation. (Rule 6.A)
