Resolution in Support of Election Officials and the Integrity of Our Democratic Process

WHEREAS election officials across Arizona serve as guardians of our democracy, ensuring free, fair, and secure elections despite escalating threats, disinformation, and political intimidation;

WHEREAS these public servants—many of whom are our neighbors, coworkers, and community members—have faced harassment, doxing, and baseless attacks simply for doing their jobs with integrity;

WHEREAS the deliberate spread of election lies undermines public trust, endangers lives, and erodes the foundations of representative government;

WHEREAS defending democracy means defending the people who make it possible;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Arizona Democratic Party unequivocally supports our election officials, poll workers, and administrators, and condemns all forms of intimidation, misinformation, and political interference targeting them;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we commit to uplifting the truth about our elections, educating our communities, and mobilizing to protect the infrastructure and individuals who safeguard the vote;

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that we call on local, state, and federal leaders to provide robust protections, resources, and public recognition for election officials—because democracy does not defend itself. People do.
